1. Confirmation of the Notes of the AGM held on 28 September 2013

The Notes of the Annual General Meeting held on 28 September 2013 were adopted by members present and signed by the KK Ng, the chairman of the 7th Executive Committee.

2. Any Other Business

- 2.1 Principal Li briefed the latest school development and activities as follows.
 - a) The Speech Day would be held on 6th June 2014 evening. Dr. Fung and All members all committee members were invited to attend the Speech Day. Vincent Lau will prepare a flower display on behalf of the association.

- b) The School's Incorporated Management Committee was officially commissioned.
- c) A 5-day External Review from the Education Bureau would take place at school.
- d) The results of HKDSE 2013 indicated the students on average had positive gains in 11 subjects including the core subjects.
- e) Our school was granted more government funds this year for different programs including outward bound trips for 120 students, joint-program with CUHK, various performance, sports, disciplinary and athletic training etc.
- f) The enrollment of form one students for 2013/14 was satisfactory with more application than vacancies.
- g) The athletic team achieved the second runner-up in the 20th Hong Kong Catholic Diocesan Secondary Schools Joint Athletics Meet.
- h) The rugby teams had achieved excellent results in the Inter-School Rugby competitions. Sports award were granted to these teams by the OBA.
- The government apparently had tight funding on building new campus which inevitably affected the likelihood of re-locating our school. The schedule for releasing new campus site for bidding was still an unknown subject.

- j) Principal Li wished to have more academic scholarship set for the students as a result of more government funds gained.
- k) All Executive Committee members were invited to attend the Form 1 parent's night on 15th July.
- Approaching the 50th Anniversary, there should be an organizing committee formed for the various activities. Upon deliberation, the anniversary gala dinner was tentatively scheduled in November / December 2015.

- 2.2 YY further briefed the latest academic development and activities as follows.
- a) There had been some new challenges of having a few ethic minority students and also students with Special Education Need (SEN) and Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD) who needed special attention. One social worker and two trained associates were specifically assigned to assist these students. However, the turn-over rate of the associates was high. Teachers were given extra training to provide necessary assistance to these students.
- b) YY circulated the evaluation of the Poon Choy dinner held on 15 February which showed very positive feedbacks. The school has sponsored 3 tables for form six students this year. YY suggested avoiding the Standard Chartered Marathon while deciding the date of Poon Choy Dinner in the future, since some retired teachers and old boys were unable to join this function instead of joining the marathon.
- c) A Career Talk was held on 11th October 2013 but the mock interview section for form six students was cancelled because of insufficient interviewers. Members showed regret of the cancellation and wished to continue this activity with better arrangement in the future.
- d) YY suggested the Career Talk, Mock Interview and Poon Choy Dinner shall become the regular activities of the OBA. Since universities would conduct interviews in March, it was recommended to organize the mock interview before March.
